- That they will be responsible for the repair or replacement costs of the laptop that result from the inappropriate use while it is loaned to the student, including the payment of insurance excess of \$400.
- The laptop will be returned to Wairoa College when the requirement for distance learning ends, or to pay the cost of replacement.
